Book Harvest's 2023 Books on Break program provided 14,208 students with 70,389 books in 35 public elementary schools and childcare centers. Books on Break ran from May 4 through May 22, reaching every student in 30 Durham Public Schools, along with schools and Pre-K sites in Columbus, Bladen, and Guilford Counties.

Students selected brand new books from a wide array of diverse and highinterest titles in both English and Spanish. Books on Break is a joyful, exciting way to help students build their home libraries and equip students with high-interest books to help them practice reading all summer long.

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#### **Books on Break 2023 Impact**

The following information was collected from 55 surveys completed by teachers, media coordinators, and school personnel.

100% of teachers report that the students expressed excitement about reading the books selected

100% of teachers report that their students are better equipped to maintain reading skills over the summer

100% would recommend Books on Break to other teachers and schools

100% of teachers report that the program supports their school's literacy goals for their students
